* To enable a smooth transition of children from primary to Secondary schools.

* To work as partners with parents and community to enable each child to flourish.

It is important that children are provided with rich experiences through play and activities that develop critical thinking and problem-solving, understanding about themselves which are age and developmentally appropriate.
